### 2. Benefits of taking AP Exam

- a. Potential College Credit
- b. \$92 for cost of test vs. \$500 or more for college course
- c. Students with free/reduces lunch take exams for free

### 3. AP Exam Registration

- b. Click on AP Testing
  - i. Click on the link under "AP Test Registration"
  - ii. Complete the Google form of your intent to test.
  - iii. **If you register and do not pay, no exam will be ordered for you.**
- c. Late Testing is only for special circumstances.
  - i. IB test on same day/time as AP test
    - 1. IB students: it is your responsibility to check to see if you have a testing conflict
  - ii. Athletic/Academic events hosted by HCPS
  - iii. See instructions on the AP registration form if you need to take a late test.
- d. Registration and Fee Payment Deadline
  - i. Friday, March 17, 2017
  - ii. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS**

### 4. AP Exam Payments

- a. Must be made in the Counseling office to Mrs. Lewis or Mrs. Moss
  - i. Cash, Check or Money order
  - ii. \$92 per exam
  - iii. Free/reduced lunch—Free
  - iv. **No exam will be ordered without documented payment**
