1) Bottar Leone Scholarship - \$2,500 - 2 Awards (Deadline: July 1, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) In academic "good standing" with a high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.0+ on a 4-point scale (or equivalent);

B) Documented physical or learning disability (students with ADD/ADHD alone are not eligible); and

2) BankMobile Financial Empowerment Scholarship - \$1,500 - 1 Award (Deadline: July 19, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a citizen of the United States.

B) If you are not in college, you must provide Proof of Enrollment/Acceptance

3) ERCA Community Contribution Scholarship - \$5,000 - 18 Awards (Deadline: July 25, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school student who is a legal residents of the United States.

B) Have recognized a need or problem in their community and have developed an action plan to help solve it.

4) Bachus and Schanker LLC Scholarship - \$2,000 – 1 Award (Deadline: July 30, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school senior accepted to attend a four-year university by the time of the award, or full time student attending a four-year university in the United States who carries a 3.0 cumulative GPA may apply.

5) Abrahamson and Uiterwyk Scholarship - \$1,500 - 1 Award (Deadline: July 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a resident of the United States.

B) Be a current high school senior OR a current college student.

6) HP Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: July 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a legal resident of the 50 United States.

B) Be 13 years or older at the time of entry,

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- B) Be a High School Senior or Undergraduate with less than 90 credit hours

9) Design Thinking Scholarship - \$1,000 - 2 Awards (Deadline: July 31, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be enrolled in a degree-granting program at an accredited two or four-year college or university located in the United States.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a High School student that is at least 13 years of age or older.

11) Nurses Make a Difference Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: Aug. 1, 2018)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school student who has been accepted into a college and plan to study nursing.
- B) Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.0.
- C) Be a legal resident of the USA or hold a valid student visa.

- A) Be attending college or university no later than January of 2019.
- B) Have achieved a GPA of 3.0 or greater during their last academic year.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be residing in the USA with High School Diploma, GED or equivalent.
- B) Be enrolled for the Spring 2019 session at the latest.
