

# SUPER FAFSA PROJECT Virginia

## What Information Do I Need to Fill Out the FAFSA?

To complete your FAFSA, you will need the information listed below for yourself and your parents if you are a dependent student or spouse if you are married.

- An FSA ID. Students and parents can apply for an FSA ID at <https://fsaid.ed.gov>.
- Social Security Number
- Driver's license (if available)
- Tax records. On the 2017-18 FAFSA, applicants will report 2015 income information, rather than 2016 income information.
- Records of untaxed income such as child support received, interest income, veterans non-education benefits. On the 2017-18 FAFSA, applicants will report 2015 tax or calendar year information.
- Records of all assets including savings and checking account balances, and investments such as stocks and bonds and real estate. Applicants will report current amounts as of the date the FAFSA is signed.
- List of schools the student is interested in attending
- Alien registration card (if not a U.S. citizen)
