

## What To Bring To On-Site Admissions

### Virginia State University, Monday, November 16 at 9:30am

- Prefer students to submit online applications before the on-site visit
- Official transcripts
- SAT/ACT scores

### Radford University (Early Action only)

#### Tuesday, November 17 at 10:00am

- Students must submit their online applications by 11/6 (Friday)
- Official transcripts
- SAT/ACT scores

### Norfolk State University, Thursday, November 19 at 9:15am

- Students interested in on site admissions should have:
  - at least a 2.3 GPA \*\*\*\*\*Students with a 3.0 GPA and above are automatically admitted without test scores\*\*\*\*\*
  - 800 SAT (Math and Reading only) or 17 ACT
  - completed an online application: <https://secure.vzcollegeapp.com/nsu/>

### Liberty University, Friday, November 20 at 11:00am

- The \$40 application fee will be waived as long as students apply on-site in one sitting with the admission counselor
- They will do on-site admissions as long as they have the appropriate admissions documents for review:
  - a. Application (will be available on paper to complete on-site)
  - b. 200-400 word essay on the following topic: *“How will your personal faith and beliefs contribute to Liberty’s mission to develop Christ-centered leaders?”*
  - c. Official transcripts (must be signed and/or notarized by school administrator to be considered official)
  - d. Official SAT/ACT test scores (if not included on transcript, must be official report from college board. Printouts from student’s online account will not be official and cannot guarantee a decision)
